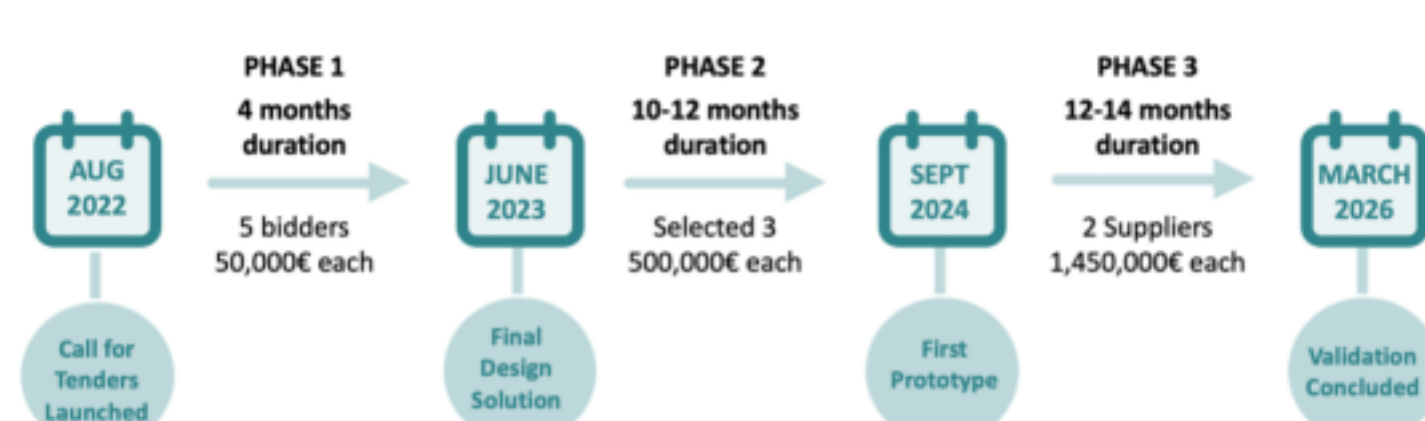
CRANE Tender Published



CRANE has launched its Pre-Commercial Procurement on the 5th of September 2022 that will be open for until the 6th of November 2022 at 23.59 CET to procure from bidders that develop and/or integrate:

- an open and interoperable platform hosting and providing access to CRANE services;
- implement secure protocols for health data management through a virtual data-lake;
- management of informed consent and building trust for patients to control the access to their own data;
- services for self-management of cardiovascular diseases (CVDs), diabetes and chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD);
- evidence-backed services for adherence, engagement and motivation.

CRANE procurement will be implemented as a 3-phases competition where PCP contracts are assigned under the supervision of the buyers' group. In the first phase, five bidders with a 50,000€ budget each for the development of a feasibility study will be invited. In Phase 2, each of the three selected proposals from Phase 1 will get 500,000€ to develop a prototype. Finally, in Phase 3 two suppliers will be selected with 1,45M€ for a Field Testing.

News from other PCP Related Projects

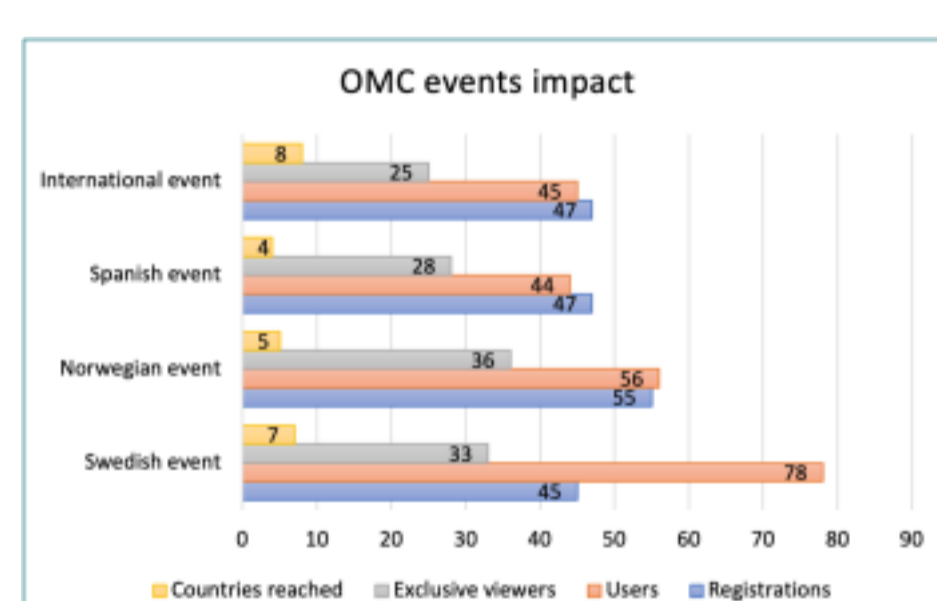

Insights from CRANE OMC

From the 18th of April to the 20th of June 2022 CRANE members organized an Open Market Consultation (OMC) to engage stakeholders and attract good proposals for the Pre-commercial procurement. A brokerage event and four open events were organized, one in each of the buyer's regions involved in the project, and an international one. The attending industry discussed with CRANE partners the tender process, objectives, and scope and provide feedback about the current state of the art of their technologies. The OMC helped to further refine the CRANE model and improve the project's views about the available technologies, capabilities and possibilities.

In total more than 60 different companies have participated in our events distributed regionally as can be seen in the graph below
