The procurement

Pre-Commercial Procurement of R&D (Research and Development) Services to develop and ICT enabled comprehensive treatment of chronic patients in rural areas (CRANE)

The Buyers Group

Cross Technology Solutions AB	The tender was not submitted on time.
NEXTER srl	<p>According to section 3.3 Selection criteria in TD1 the tenderer must have the ability to perform R&D up to original development of the first products or services.</p> <p>NEXTER srl is not a part of a consortium and it not using any subcontractors. NEXTER srl is a start-up company with less then 10 employees. The submitted CV, the reference projects and the other evidence do not show that the ability to perform R&D up to original development of the first products or services is met.</p>

Evaluation

The remaining 18 tenders were evaluated according to section 3.4.2 Weighted award criteria, 3.4.3 Point system, 3.5 Price-quality ratio and 3.6 Evaluation procedure: Opening of tenders & evaluation in TD1. The evaluation carried out led to the following results:
