

# PROCUREMENT REPORT AND EVALUATION PROTOCOL - CRANE PCP

# The procurement

Pre-Commercial Procurement of R&D (Research and Development) Services to develop and ICT enabled comprehensive treatment of chronic patients in rural areas (CRANE)

## The Buyers Group

Region Västerbotten, Sweden, is the lead procurer and has been appointed to coordinate and lead the joint CRANE PCP, and to sign and award the Framework Agreement and the specific contracts for all phases of the PCP, in the name and on behalf of the Buyers Group, which also consists of Region Agder, Norway, and Region Extremadura, Spain.

## **Proposed Decision**

The contracts for phase 3 in the procurement are – without any mutual ranking – awarded to:

- 1) LCubed AB (iGrant.io) (Decentralised Health Data Space Infrastructure dHDSI)
- 2) Data for Good foundation (Data for Care)

#### **Tenders received**

In phase 3 of the procurement, the following tenderers were invited to submit a tender:

- 1) LCubed AB (iGrant.io) (Decentralised Health Data Space Infrastructure dHDSI)
- 2) Data for Good foundation (Data for Care)
- 3) Televes S.A.U. (My Rural Health)

All of the invited tenderers submitted a tender.

# Exclusion criterias, selection criterias, On/off criterias and formal requirements

All tenders met the exclusion criterias, selection criterias, On/off criterias and/or the formal requirements. Therefore, all tenders were approved for the next step in the process, the evaluation of the tenders.

#### Evaluation

All the tenders were evaluated according to section 3.4.2 Weighted award criteria, 3.4.3 Points system, 3.5 Price-quality ratio and 3.6 Evaluation procedure: Opening of tenders & evaluation in TD1. The evaluation carried out led to the following results:

# Procedures for appeal

Please note that this is a pre-commercial procurement that is not covered by the EU procurement directives or Swedish law on public procurement. This means that it is not possible to obtain a Swedish administrative court's review of the decision made by the Buyers Group.

The Buyers Groups observes a voluntary standstill period for 15 days.
